IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND-BIGHTY.

AN ACT concerning the acknowledgment of deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The acknowledgment of deeds may
- 2 be made before any notary public in this state.
 - SECT. 2. All acknowledgment of deeds hereto-
- 2 fore made in this state before a notary public duly
- 3 commissioned and qualified, shall be deemed and
- 4 taken to be legal and valid.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
