STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT to incorporate the Beech Hill Brook Dam
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. John F. Whitcomb and Charles H.
2 Haynes, their heirs, associates and assigns, are
3 hereby created a body politic and corporate by the
4 name of the Beech Hill brook dam company, with
5 the powers and privileges of similar corporations.

SECT. 2. Said corporation may erect and main-
2 tain a dam on their own land at the outlet of Beech
3 Hill pond, in the town of Otis, for the purpose of
4 raising a head of water to run their mill and to
5 facilitate the driving of logs and other lumber.

SECT. 3. The said corporation may demand and
2 receive a toll of fifteen cents per thousand feet for
3 all logs, and ten cents per cord for all stave or
4 shingle wood which may pass over or through said
5 dam, and a lien is hereby created on all logs and
6 staves or shingle wood which shall pass over or
7 through said dam for the payment of such tolls,
8 but the logs or other lumber of each particular
9 mark shall only be holden for the payment of such
10 mark, and if said toll is not paid within thirty days
11 after said logs or other lumber arrives at its place
12 of destination, the said corporation may sell at
13 auction, after ten days' notice in any newspaper
14 printed in Hancock county, so much of such logs
15 or lumber as may be sufficient to pay said toll and
16 incidental expenses.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
