## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred seventeen of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-nine, relating to suits involving tax titles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and seventeen, of the public-

- 2 laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, is
- 3 hereby amended so as to read as follows:
- 4 No person contesting the validity of any sale of
- 5 land for non-payment of taxes, shall be permitted
- 6 to commence, maintain or defend any action at law
- 7 or in equity, involving the validity of such sale
- 8 until he shall have deposited with the clerk of the
- 9 court in which such action is to be commenced or
- 10 defended, the of amount of all taxes, interest and

- 11 costs accruing under such sale, and of all taxes
- 12 paid after such sale and interest thereon, to be paid
- 13 out by order of court to the party legally and
- 14 equitably entitled thereto.
