STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on the counties of the state.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties
2 in the following schedule, are hereby granted as a
3 tax on each county respectively, to be appropriated,
4 assessed, collected and applied for the purpose of
5 paying the debts and necessary expenses of the
6 same, and other purposes ordered by law, to wit:
7 Androscoggin, twenty-eight thousand dollars;
8 Aroostook, fourteen thousand dollars; Cumberland
9 fifty-five thousand dollars; Franklin, seven thou-
10 sand dollars; Hancock, twelve thousand dollars;
11 Knox, sixteen thousand dollars; Kennebec, thirty-
12 eight thousand dollars; Lincoln, eight thousand
13 dollars; Oxford, eleven thousand dollars; Penob-
14 scot, forty thousand dollars; Piscataquis, six thou-
15 sand dollars; Sagadahoc, sixteen thousand five

16 hundred dollars; Somerset, eleven thousand five
17 hundred dollars; Washington, sixteen thousand
18 dollars; Waldo, sixteen thousand dollars; York,
19 eighteen thousand dollars.
