## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to vest the franchise and property of Arrowsic bridge in the inhabitants of Sagadahoc county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The inhabitants of the town of Arrow-

- 2 sic are hereby authorized and empowered by a ma-
- 3 jority vote at any legal town meeting to transfer
- 4 and convey, as a gift to the inhabitants of the
- 5 county of Sagadahoc, the stock and franchise of
- 6 the Arrowsic bridge company, incorporated under
- 7 an act of the legislature approved July seventeen,
- 8 eighteen hundred and forty-nine, and now held by
- 9 said town by force of an act of the legislature ap-
- 10 proved February second, eighteen hundred and
- 11 seventy-two.

SECT. 2. The county of Sagadahoc is hereby au-2 thorized and empowered to take and hold said 3 bridge as a toll-bridge, with the franchise, build-4 ings, land and appurtenances thereto belonging, 5 and to maintain the same in suitable repair.

Sect. 3. The county commissioners for the county 2 of Sagadahoc are hereby authorized to maintain 3 and keep in repair said bridge, so that the same 4 may be safe and convenient for public travel, and 5 to include in their annual estimates of county taxes 6 the sums required therefor; and they may provide 7 for any extraordinary repairs by hiring money on 8 the credit of the county, and issue bonds or notes 9 of the county therefor on time not to exceed twenty 10 years, to be signed by the county treasurer and 11 countersigned by said commissioners.

SECT. 4. The county commissioners of said county 2 of Sagadahoc shall regulate and establish from time 3 to time such rates of toll as shall in their judgment 4 be sufficient to maintain said bridge, and give pub-5 lic notice thereof. They shall employ a suitable 6 person, at a stipulated salary, to superintend the 7 bridge and collect the tolls, who shall render to the 8 county commissioners on the first day of each and 9 every month a statement, under oath, of the amount 10 of tolls collected during the preceding month, and

- 11 pay the same to the county treasurer, and who shall
- 12 receive his salary from the county treasurer on
- 13 the written order of the county commissioners, and
- 14 not otherwise; and all excess of moneys so received
- 15 into the county treasury over and above what is re-
- 16 quired for necessary expenses and repairs shall be
- 17 set aside and shall constitute a sinking fund for the
- 18 payment of said bonds or notes as may be issued
- 19 by virtue of this act.
  - SECT. 5. This act shall be inoperative, unless the
  - 2 inhabitants of said county at their annual town
  - 3 meetings in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
  - 4 one shall by a majority vote accept the same.
    - Sect. 6. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
  - 2 with this act are hereby repealed.
