STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT for the protection of smelts in Pleasant river in the county of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall not be lawful to obstruct in

- 2 any way, by any net, seine, weir, or other contriv-
- 3 ance for taking smelts, more than one-eighth part
- 4 of the channel from either shore of Pleasant river,
- 5 in the county of Washington, under a penalty of
- 6 not less than fifty nor more than five hundred dol-
- 7 lars for each offense, to be recovered before any
- 8 competent tribunal, by complaint, indictment or
- 9 action of debt. One-half of said penalty shall be
- 10 for the party prosecuting or making complaint, and
- 11 the other half to said county. Provided, that noth-

- 12 ing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit
- 13 the taking of smelts in said river by a common dip-
- 14 net or by hook and line.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
