STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Oakfield plantation.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be authorized and directed to deliver to the treasurer of Oakfield plantation, the municipal war debt bonds awarded to said plantation by the commissioners on equalization of municipal war debts, as provided by an act of the legislature approved March seven, eighteen hundred sixty-eight, and the amendment thereto, approved March three, eighteen hundred ninety-nine, amounting to six hundred dollars in bonds, and sixty-six 67-100 dollars in currency; said bonds being now on deposit in the office of the treasurer of state.
