STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend section sixteen of chapter six of the revised statutes, relating to the taxation of the capital stock of toll bridges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section sixteen of chapter six of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding after the word
2 "reside" in the second line thereof, the words
3 "except stock owned by persons residing out of
4 the state, which shall be taxed in the town or
5 towns where the bridge is located; and where such
6 bridge is located in two towns, one-half of the tax
7 upon such stock shall be assessed in each town,"
8 so that said section when amended shall read as follows:

11 The stock of all toll bridges shall be taxed as
12 personal property, to the owners thereof, in the
13 towns where they reside, except stock owned by
14 persons residing out of the state, which shall be
15 taxed in the town or towns where the bridge is
16 located, and when such bridge is located in two
17 towns one-half of the tax upon such stock shall be
18 assessed in each town.
