STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT relating to trustees and other officers of public institutions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. No trustee, superintendent, treasurer, 2 or other person holding a place of trust in any 3 state office or public institution of this state, shall 4 be interested directly or indirectly in any contracts 5 made in behalf of the state or of the institution in 6 which he holds such place of trust, and any contract 7 made in violation hereof shall be void; and if such 8 officer or person shall receive any drawbacks, 9 presents, gratuities or secret discounts to his own

10 use on account of such contracts, he shall be pun-
11 ished by imprisonment not more than a year, or by
12 fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
