## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter ninety-one of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section ten of chapter ninety-one of

- 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding
- 3 thereto the words "and whenever a vessel shall
- 4 have been attached as aforesaid, and the expense
- 5 of retaining possession of said vessel shall be great,
- 6 or the vessel shall be liable to depreciate in value
- 7 by reason thereof, any attaching creditor, or an
- 8 owner of said vessel may, in term time or vacation,
- 9 petition a justice of the supreme judicial court,
- 10 praying that said vessel attached as aforesaid may

11 be sold; and said justice may order a hearing on 12 said petition; and due notice shall be given to all 13 parties in interest, of the time and place appointed 14 for said hearing, and a hearing on said petition 15 shall be had before a justice of said court; and if 16 it shall then appear to said justice to be for the 17 benefit of all parties in interest that said vessel should 18 be sold, said justice shall issue to the officer in 19 possession of said vessel, or to the sheriff of the 20 county in which said vessel has been attached, an to sell said vessel at public auction, and said 2122 justice shall designate in said order the notice to 23 be given of the time and place of said sale; and 24 said vessel shall be sold pursuant to 25 order, and the proceeds of said sale, after deduct-26 ing necessary expenses, shall be held by the first 27 attaching officer, or the sheriff, subject to the suc-28 cessive attachments as if sold on execution; pro-29 vided, however, that if said parties do not consent 30 to a sale as herein provided, the provisions of 31 sections twenty-nine to thirty-eight inclusive, of 32 chapter eighty-one of the revised statutes, so far 33 as the same are applicable, shall apply to proceed-34 ings under this act."

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
