STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT providing for the recording in the registry of deeds of judgments in real actions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. All final judgments in real actions
2 shall be recorded in the registry of deeds of the
3 county, or registry district, in which the land af-
4 fected by such judgments is situated, and within
5 thirty days after rendition of such judgment.

SECT. 2. The clerk of courts of the county in
2 which such judgment is rendered, shall within said
3 thirty days file with such register of deeds a cer-
4 tified copy of such judgment, which copy shall be
5 recorded by such register. The clerk's and regis-
6 ter's fees for such service, shall be taxed in the
7 costs in such action.
