STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and sixty-one, section two, of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, in relation to the state valuation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section second of chapter one hundred and sixty-one of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, is hereby amended by striking out the word "next" in the second line; also, the words "on the second Monday of January next" in the third line, and inserting the words "present, or any future;" also, by inserting therein, after the word "original" in the fourth line, the words "or full copies of the original poll lists and valuation lists, duly certified and sworn to by their asses-

11 sors," so that said section, as amended, shall read
12 as follows:

13 *Sect. 2.* The assessors of every city, town and
14 plantation shall also produce or cause to be pro-
15 duced before the present or any future legislature
16 for their examination the full original or full copies
17 of the original poll lists and valuation lists, duly
18 certified and sworn to by their assessors, of their
19 several cities, towns and plantations for the years
20 eighteen hundred seventy-seven, eighteen hundred
21 seventy-eight and eighteen hundred seventy-nine.

SECT. 3. Notice of the passage of this act shall
2 forthwith be given by the secretary of state to all
3 cities, towns and plantations, that have not yet sent
4 in either the original or certified copies of such
5 lists.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
