## STATE OF MAINE.

**RESOLVE** in favor of executors of Alfred Veazie.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars 2 now standing to the credit of Plantation E in 3 Franklin county be paid to the executors of Alfred 4 Veazie, with interest from the time it was deposited 5 in the treasury, being for money paid by said 6 Veazie for deed of the right to cut timber and 7 grass on the public lots in said plantation until the 8 township should be organized, the organization 9 having then been already effected, and the deed 10 being thus void, and the money paid without con-11 sideration. *Provided*, before payment of the 12 money said executors file with the treasurer of 13 state a release of all interest in said township, or 14 cancel the deed on the records of the land office.
