IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY.

AN ACT regulating the fees of inspectors of lime  
and lime casks, and their deputies.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The fees of inspectors of lime and  
2 lime casks, and their deputies, shall be one-half  
3 mill for each cask inspected and branded, and  
4 each inspector shall receive from his deputy one-  
5 half mill for each cask inspected and branded by  
6 the deputy.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
2 with section first of this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
