STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to abolish the Calais municipal court and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter seventy-two of the private

- 2 and special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-
- 3 eight relating to the establishment of the Calais
- 4 municipal court and matters connected therewith,
- 5 is hereby repealed, and said court, on and after the
- 6 expiration of three months from the tenth day of
- 7 March, eighteen hundred and eighty, shall be
- 8 abolished. The passage of this act shall not be
- 9 held to restore the municipal court of the city of
- 10 Calais, but said municipal court is hereby likewise
- 11 abolished.

Sect. 2. No writ or process shall be made re-2 turnable to said Calais municipal court, and no 3 suit or action shall be entered therein after the 4 third Tuesday of March, eighteen hundred and 5 eighty, but said court shall be continued and hold 6 its sessions for three months thereafter for the 7 purpose of the hearing, decision and disposition of 8 all actions and matters pending in said court. 9 All actions and other matters pending before said 10 court and not finally disposed of at the expiration 11 of three months, shall be transferred to the 12 supreme judicial court for Washington county, 13 and shall there be entered, heard and determined 14 in the same manner as if originally commenced in 15 said court, and full costs shall be recovered by the 16 prevailing party. All the records, documents and 17 papers belonging to the said Calais municipal court 18 and said municipal court of the city of Calais 19 shall be deposited and kept in the clerk's office 20 of said supreme judicial court for Washington 21 county, and certified copies thereof shall be used 22 as evidence whenever the originals would be ad-23 missible. The clerk of the supreme judicial court 24 shall have power to renew all executions issued by 25 either said Calais municipal court or said municipal 26 court of Calais, and issue other executions therefor 27 in the same manner as if said executions had been 28 originally issued by said clerk.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
