
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT in relation to the bridge over the east branch of Cousins's river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The towns of Freeport and Yarmouth are hereby

- 2 authorized to construct the bridge over the east
- 3 branch of Cousins's river, between Freeport and
- 4 Yarmouth, without a draw, but leaving sufficient
- 5 width between the abutments so that the naviga-
- 6 tion of the river shall not be unnecessarily
- 7 obstructed.
