IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY.

AN ACT in relation to the bridge over the east  
branch of Cousins's river.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The towns of Freeport and Yarmouth are hereby  
2 authorized to construct the bridge over the east  
3 branch of Cousins's river, between Freeport and  
4 Yarmouth, without a draw, but leaving sufficient  
5 width between the abutments so that the naviga-  
6 tion of the river shall not be unnecessarily  
7 obstructed.
