STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty-eight of the revised
statutes, relating to agricultural societies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Chapter fifty-eight of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended, by adding thereto the
3 following section, to wit:
4 *Sect. 18.* If any person shall sell any refresh-
5 ments, or other merchandise, or exhibit any show
6 or play within one mile of the fair grounds of any
7 agricultural society, during the time of any exhi-
8 bition of said society, unless in the usual and ordi-
9 nary course and place of business of such person,
10 or let any land or building adjoining or overlooking
11 the fair grounds of such society, to spectators of

12 any exhibition of said society, during the time of
13 such exhibition, without the written consent of the
14 trustees of said society, he shall be punished by a
15 fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, to be re-
16 covered on complaint of two of the trustees, for
17 the use of said society.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
