STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT in relation to sureties upon official bonds
defending in suits against their principal.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Sureties upon official bonds may
2 appear and defend in suits against their principal,
3 whenever such sureties may ultimately be liable
4 upon such bonds.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
