IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY.

AN ACT to provide for the registry of deeds from  
the state.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

A copy from the records now in the land office,  
2 of a deed from the state of the land of the state,  
3 or a deed from the state and the commonwealth of  
4 Massachusetts of the undivided lands of the state  
5 and said commonwealth, certified by the secretary  
6 of the state and approved by the governor as a  
7 true copy of such record, may be filed and recorded  
8 in the registry of deeds in the county where the  
9 land lies, and shall have the same effect as if the

10 deed itself had been recorded instead of the copy;  
11 and certified copies thereof shall be evidence when  
12 the original would be.
