STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to provide for the registry of deeds from the state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

A copy from the records now in the land office,

- 2 of a deed from the state of the land of the state,
- 3 or a deed from the state and the commonwealth of
- 4 Massachusetts of the undivided lands of the state
- 5 and said commonwealth, certified by the secretary
- 6 of the state and approved by the governor as a
- 7 true copy of such record, may be filed and recorded
- 8 in the registry of deeds in the county where the
- 9 land lies, and shall have the same effect as if the

- 10 deed itself had been recorded instead of the copy;
- 11 and certified copies thereof shall be evidence when
- 12 the original would be.
