STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide for the erection of an additional building to the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine insane hospital be and are hereby authorized to erect a suitable building for the accommodation and better classification of patients, at some point on the hospital premises; *provided,* the means for the purpose can be drawn from the accrued funds and current income of the hospital during the years eighteen hundred eighty and eighteen hundred eighty-one. But not more than eighty-five per cent. of such funds or income shall be used in any one year. The cost of such building shall not exceed the sum of eighteen thousand dollars. Chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the resolves of eighteen hundred seventy-nine is hereby repealed.
