STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide for the erection of an additional building to the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine insane 2 hospital be and are hereby authorized to erect a 3 suitable building for the accommodation and better 4 classification of patients, at some point on the hos-5 pital premises; provided, the means for the pur-6 pose can be drawn from the accrued funds and cur-7 rent income of the hospital during the years eight-8 een hundred eighty and eighteen hundred eighty-9 one. But not more than eighty-five per cent. of 10 such funds or income shall be used in any one year. 11 The cost of such building shall not exceed the sum 12 of eighteen thousand dollars. Chapter one hun-13 dred and thirty-six of the resolves of eighteen hun-14 dred seventy-nine is hereby repealed.
