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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

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AN ACT to amend section sixteen of chapter forty-six of the revised statutes relating to corporations.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section sixteen of chapter forty-six of the revised  
2 statutes is hereby amended by adding after the  
3 word "attached," in the third line thereof, the words  
4 "and appraised and set off on execution," so that  
5 said section when amended shall read as follows:

6 *Sect. 16.* Corporations existing by the laws of  
7 another state, or of a foreign jurisdiction, may sue  
8 or be sued by their corporate name in this state;  
9 and if they have property in this state it may be  
10 attached and appraised and set off on execution as  
11 the property of non-resident individuals. The acts

12 of their agents are to have the same effect as the  
13 acts of agents of foreign private persons, unless  
14 prohibited by law.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
