AN ACT granting permission to S. E. Bryant,.
Anthony Luques, J. A. Wheeler and others to locate and construct a railroad from Kennebunk to Kennebunkport, in the county of York, upon certain conditions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives. in Legislature assembled, as follows:

10 Moody, M. C. Maling, H. T. Fairfield and their 11 associates, to locate and construct a railroad from 12 Kennebunk to Kennebunkport, in the county of 13 York, whenever they shall have been legally or-14 ganized under chapter one hundred and twenty of 15 the public laws of the year one thousand, eight 16 hundred and seventy-six, and shall have complied 17 with all the provisions thereof; provided, however, 18 that this permission is granted subject to the 19 condition that a suitable draw, such as shall be 20 determined by the railroad commissioners to be 21 necessary, shall be constructed and maintained in 22 any bridge over tide waters where vessels can 23 navigate.
