STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to authorize the Knox and Lincoln railroad company to change its location.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The Knox and Lincoln railroad
2 company is hereby authorized to change the line
3 of its location in the towns of the Edgecomb and
4 Newcastle, and to construct and maintain a road
5 and bridge from a point in its present line easterly
6 of the covered bridge across the Sheepscot river,
7 over tide waters, and near the shore of said river in
8 an easterly direction to another point in the present
9 line of said railroad; and to discontinue such part
10 of the old line of railroad as shall be suspended
11 and rendered unnecessary by the new line hereby

12 authorized; and said company shall have the same
13 rights, privileges, powers and immunities, and be
14 subject to the same duties and liabilities in respect
15 to the location, construction, maintenance, use and
16 management of the portion of road hereby author-
17 ized as are granted and imposed by the original
18 act incorporating said company, and acts amenda-
19 tory thereof and additional thereto.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
