STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT relating to town and private ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The owner or tenant of any land over
2 or across which any town way or private way has
3 been or shall be located by municipal officers, shall
4 have the same right of appeal as is provided in
5 section twenty-three (23) of chapter eighteen of
6 the revised statutes.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
