STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT relating to ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. No private way, town way, city street,
2 or highway, shall hereafter be located, taking any
3 land of any railroad corporation in this state, un-
4 less a notice of the time and place of the hearing
5 upon said location shall have been served upon the
6 station agent of said railroad within such town or
7 city, if any there be, and otherwise upon such sta-
8 tion agent whose station is nearest to the land pro-
9 posed to be so taken, at least seven days before the
10 time for such hearing.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its approval by the governor.
