#### RESOLVE in favor of Edmund D. Wiggin.

In Council, March 3, 1880.

The Standing Committee on Accounts, to which was referred the claim of E. D. Wiggin, for services and expenses as detective, under the appointment of Attorney General Emery, in matter of alleged robbery of the Dexter Savings Bank and murder of the Cashier. Barron, under Resolve of the Legislature, chapter 148, 1879, approved March 3, 1879:

Report, That of the whole sum claimed, viz. \$3,435.39, they find due said Wiggin the sum of \$1,726.24 from the State, of which sum one thousand dollars by assignment of said Wiggin, on file in this case, is to be paid to the Dexter Savings Bank, and the balance, \$726.24, to said Wiggin, and that separate warrants should be drawn for each of said sums to the parties entitled to it, which sums are to be in full for all claims against the State growing out of said transaction in favor of said bank, or of said Wiggin; and recommend separate appropriations therefor.
