STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Dexter Savings Bank.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars
2 be and is hereby appropriated, for the payment to
3 the Dexter savings bank, of claims against the
4 state, arising from the employment by the attorney
5 general, in eighteen hundred seventy-eight, of E.
6 D. Wiggin as detective, in the case wherein Mr. J.
7 Wilson Barron lost his life. And the said sum
8 shall be in full for all claims of the said bank
9 against the state, growing out of the said transac-
10 tion.
