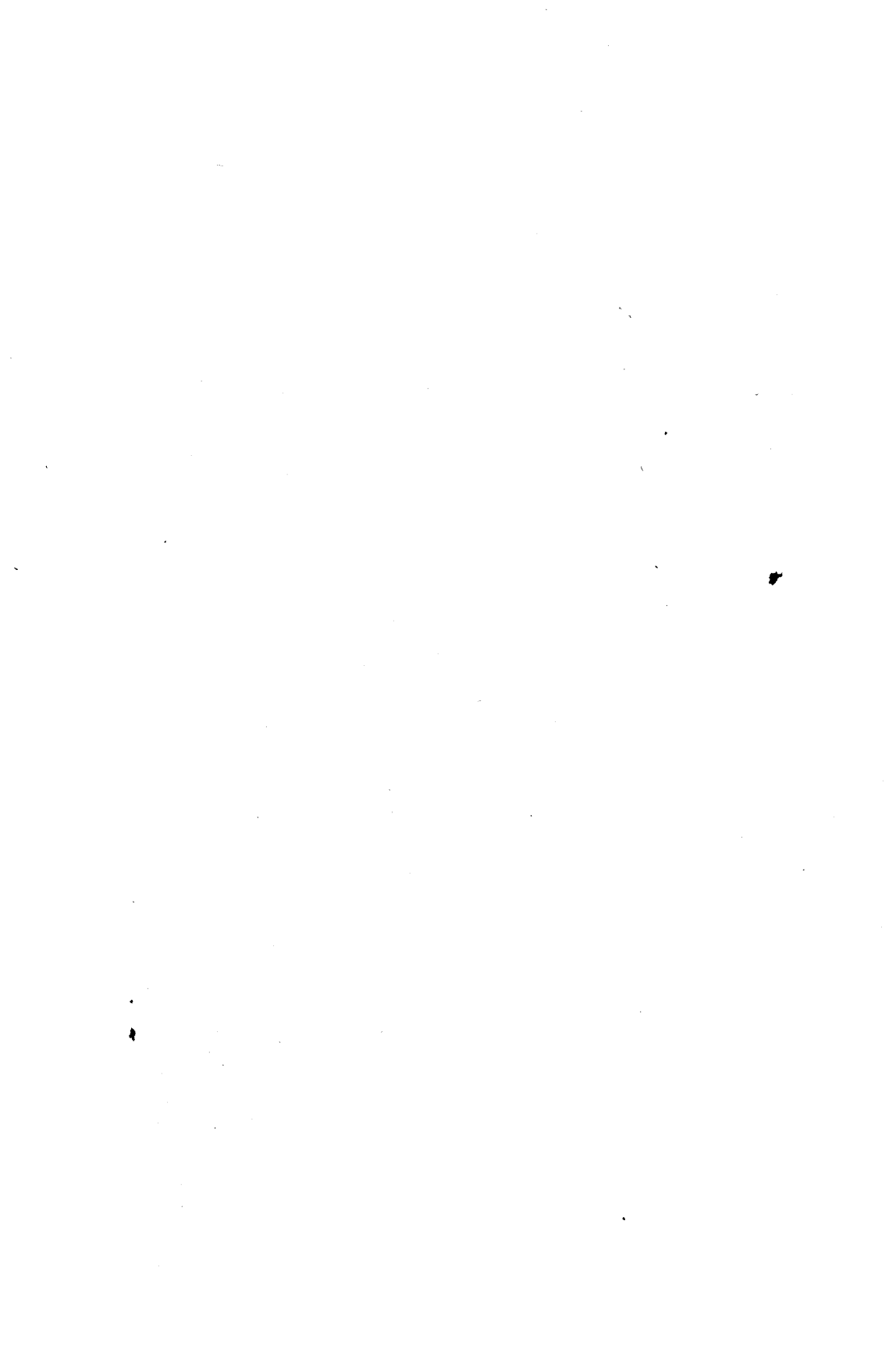
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT relating to convicts and officers in the county jails in this state having work-shops attached thereto.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

So much of sections thirty-four, thirty-five, thirty-
2 six and thirty-seven of chapter one hundred and
3 forty of the revised statutes as relates to the dis-
4 cipline and punishment of convicts in the state
5 prison, and also to the duties and protection of offi-
6 cers therein, is hereby made and is equally appli-
7 cable to convicts and officers in the county jails in
8 this state having workshops attached thereto.
