STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT relating to telephone companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The National Bell Telephone Com-2 pany of the state of Maine shall have no right to 3 locate, construct or operate lines of telephone with-4 in the limits of any other telephone company char-5 ter granted by the legislature of eighteen hundred 6 and eighty, or of previous years, until the compan-7 nies named in the other charters aforesaid are 8 granted at reasonable rates the use and full benefits 9 for their own lines of all telephone boxes and in-10 struments necessary to operate said lines.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
