STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and seventy-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Chapter one hundred and seventy-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven is hereby amended by adding after the word "executors," in the first line of the act therein set forth as amended, the word "guardians," so that said act as amended shall read as follows:

Administrators, executors, guardians, and trustees, are hereby authorized to make oath to their several accounts before a justice of the peace, in all cases, and when they reside beyond the limits

11 of this state, before a commissioner for the State
12 of Maine, or a United States consul, where no ob-
13 jection is made by parties interested to the allow-
14 ance of said account.'
