## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to actions against insolvent estates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter sixty-six of the re-2 vised statutes, is hereby amended, by striking out 3 the last line, and by substituting the word "de-4 cree" for the word "representation" wherever it 5 occurs, so that said section shall read as follows:

6 Sect. 17. Actions pending on claims not pre-7 ferred, when a decree of insolvency is made, may 8 be discontinued without costs; or continued, tried 9 and judgment rendered with the effect and satisfied 10 in the manner provided in cases of appeal. No 11 action can be commenced, except on a preferred 12 claim, after such decree.
