STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to chapter fifteen, of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and forty-one of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, relating to burying grounds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Any private cemetery or burying
2 ground, by written agreement of all the owners
3 thereof, recorded by the clerk of the town in which
4 it is situated, may by vote of such town, within
5 one month after the recording of such agreement
6 by the town clerk, become public, and subject to
7 all the provisions of law relating to public ceme-
8 teries or burying grounds; *provided*, such agree-
9 ment shall not be in conflict with the terms of any

10 conveyance or devise of land for the purposes of a
11 burying ground.
