STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty-one of chapter two hundred and thirty-nine of acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, and to amend section fifty-six of chapter forty-nine, revised statutes, relating to report of insurance commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. That section thirty-one of chapter 2 two hundred and thirty-nine, of acts of eighteen 3 hundred and eighty, be and is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. That section fifty-six of chapter 2 forty-nine, revised statutes, be and is hereby 3 amended as follows:

4 By striking out in the fifth line the word "legis-
5 ture," and inserting the words "governor and
6 council," and cause to be at once published.

7 Also insert after the word "prepare," in the
8 eighth line, the words "and publish as aforesaid,"
9 so that said section as amended shall read as fol-
10 lows:

11 "The commissioner shall preserve in a proper
12 form the statement of the condition of every com-
13 pany examined or caused to be examined by him,
14 and all which shall be rendered to him as herein
15 required; and shall annually report to the gov-
16 ernor and council, and cause to be at once pub-
17 lished, the general condition of the insurance
18 companies doing business in this state, and such
19 suggestions as he thinks proper in connection
20 therewith; shall prepare and publish as aforesaid,
21 an abstract of all returns and statements made to
22 him by insurance companies.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
