## STATE OF MAINE.


IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section four of the fifty-fifth chapter of the revised statutes, relating to libraries, charitable societies, and public cemeteries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section four of the fifty-fifth chapter of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended, by striking 3 out "twenty-five," and inserting "one hundred" 4 instead thereof, so that said section as amended 5 shall read as follows:

6 Sect. 4. Such corporation may take and hold by 7 purchase, gift, devise or bequest, personal or real 8 estate, in all not exceeding in value one hundred 9 thousand dollars, owned at any one time, and use 10 and dispose thereof only for the purposes for which 11 the corporation was organized.
