## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to licenses to keep bowling alleys and billiard rooms.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives. in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section four of chapter twenty-nine of the revised 2 statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the 3 words, "and such licenses shall expire on the first 4 day of April next after they are granted unless 5 sooner revoked," so that said section, as amended, 6 shall read as follows:

7 Sect. 4. The municipal officers of towns may 8 license suitable persons to keep bowling alleys and 9 billiard rooms therein, in any place where it will 10 not disturb the peace and quiet of a family, for 11 which the person licensed shall pay ten dollars to 12 the use of such town; and such licenses shall

13 expire on the first day of April next after they are14 granted, unless sooner revoked.
