EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to prevent railroad accidents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Any person who shall get upon or leave any
2 steam engine tender or car at any place outside of
3 a railroad station, whilst such engine tender or car
4 is in motion, shall be punished by imprisonment
5 not exceeding thirty days, or by fine not exceeding
6 fifty dollars.
