## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND-EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to prevent railroad accidents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any person who shall get upon or leave any

- 2 steam engine tender or car at any place outside of
- 3 a railroad station, whilst such engine tender or car-
- 4 is in motion, shall be punished by imprisonment
- 5 not exceeding thirty days, or by fine not exceeding
- 6 fifty dollars.
