STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section forty-eight, chapter eight-
teen, of the revised statutes, relating to highway
taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section forty-eight, of chapter eighteen, of the
2 revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following words: "and the treasurer shall hold the
4 same subject to the order of the selectmen, to be
5 applied by them for repairs of roads and bridges,"
6 so that said section as amended shall read as fol-
7 lows:

8 "Sect. 48. Each surveyor at the expiration of
9 his term, is to render to the assessors a list of such
10 persons as have not worked out or paid their taxes.

11 The assessors are to place the amounts due from
12 each in distinct columns in their next assessment
13 of town taxes on such delinquents, to be collected
14 as other town taxes, and paid to the treasurer, and
15 the treasurer shall hold the same subject to the
16 order of the selectmen, to be applied by them for
17 repairs of roads and bridges.”
