SIR:—I have the honor herewith, to present a statement of the amounts expended by the trustees of this institution. for the various purposes, as directed in an order of the Houseof Representatives, addressed to me, and dated January 27th instant. I have understood the order to call for a report of such sums of money as have been directly expended for thesepurposes from the funds of the hospital, exclusive of appropriations from the state treasury, from January 1st, 1874, to January 1st, 1881, and have reported accordingly.

Other expenditures for what might be termed extraordinary improvements, but of which no separate account has been kept, have been estimated at about twelve thousand dollars.
