## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and eightytwo of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred and eighty-

- 2 two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
- 3 seventy-four is hereby amended, so as to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 "Whenever any goods, merchandise, packages
- 6 or parcels, transported by any railroad, steamboat,
- 7 express or stage company, shall remain unclaimed
- 8 for six months; or any goods, merchandise, or
- 9 other articles of personal property shall remain in
- 10 any public warehouse for six months after the

- 11 charges thereon shall be rightfully demanded and
- 12 left unpaid, the same may be sold by auction to
- 13 pay the charges thereon, and the expense of adver-
- 14 tising and selling the same."
