STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and sixteen of public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-nine, in relation to hawkers and pedlars.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and sixteen of public laws 2 of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, is hereby 3 amended, by striking out the words "twenty-five 4 dollars," and inserting in place thereof the words 5 "fifty dollars," so that said chapter as amended 6 shall read as follows:

7 "Any person receiving a license under the pro-8 visions of section two, chapter forty-four of the 9 revised statutes, shall, if he is not a resident of this 10 state, or if he is acting as agent, clerk or servant

11 of any person not a resident of this state, 12 or corporation not located in this state, pay for 13 such license, if he is to sell or offer to sell by 14 retail, fifty dollars; if by wholesale, fifty dollars.
