## STATE OF MAINE.

N THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter six of the revised statutes, relating to taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fourteen, of chapter six, of the revised

- 2 statutes is hereby amended in clause first, by strik-
- 3 ing out the last words of said clause, so that the
- 4 same shall read as follows:
- 5 "First. All goods, wares and merchandise, all
- 6 logs, timber, boards and other lumber, and all stock
- 7 in trade, including stock employed in the business
- 8 of any of the mechanic arts, in any town within
- 9 this state, other than where the owners reside,
- 10 shall be taxed in such town, if the owners, their
- 11 tenants, or any person contracting under them for

- 12 the building of any house, shop, store or vessel,
- 13 occupy any store, shop, mill, wharf, landing or
- 14 shipyard therein."
