STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter six of the revised statutes, relating to taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fourteen, of chapter six, of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended in clause first, by strik-
3 ing out the last words of said clause, so that the
4 same shall read as follows:

5 “*First.* All goods, wares and merchandise, all
6 logs, timber, boards and other lumber, and all stock
7 in trade, including stock employed in the business
8 of any of the mechanic arts, in any town within
9 this state, other than where the owners reside,
10 shall be taxed in such town, if the owners, their
11 tenants, or any person contracting under them] for

12 the building of any house, shop, store or vessel,
13 occupy any store, shop, mill, wharf, landing or
14 shipyard therein.”
