## STATE OF MAINE.

N THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section twelve, chapter forty-three of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section twelve of chapter forty-three

- 2 of the revised statutes of 1871, is hereby amended,
- 3 by striking out, after the word "county" in the
- 4 second line, the words "within two years from the
- 5 eleventh day of March, one thousand eight hun-
- 6 dred and sixty-nine, and within six months after
- 7 the formation of a new county," and by inserting
- 8 after the word "erect," in the fourth line of said
- 9 section, the words "and forever maintain," and by
- 10 inserting after the word "their" in the same line,
- 11 the word "several," and by striking out after the

- 12 word "counties" in said fourth line, the words "on
- 13 land owned by the county, or for that purpose ac-
- 14 quired by them," and by striking out in the ninth
- 15 line of said section, after the word "shall," the
- 16 words "and enclose," so that said section when so
- 17 amended shall read as follows:
- 18 Sect. 12. The county commissioners, at the ex-
- 19 pense of their county, shall erect and forever main-
- 20 tain in their several counties, at such place or
- 21 places as the public convenience requires, a true
- 22 meridian line, to be perpetuated by stone pillars,
- 23 with brass or copper points firmly fixed on the tops
- 24 thereof, indicating the true range of such meridian,
- 25 and shall protect the same, and provide a book of
- 26 records to be kept by the clerk of the courts, or by
- 27 a person appointed by them nearer to such struc-
- 28 ture, and accessible to all persons wishing to refer
- 29 thereto.
- 30 Section sixteen of chapter forty-three aforesaid,
- 31 is hereby amended, by striking out after the word
- 32 "meridian" in the first line of said section, the
- 33 words "is so established," and inserting in place
- 34 thereof, the words "or meridians are established,
- 35 repaired, or rebuilt," so that said section when so
- 36 amended shall read as follows:

37 When such meridian or meridians are Sect. 16. 38 established, repaired, or rebuilt, in any county, the 39 governor and council shall appoint a competent 40 commissioner to inspect and verify it by astronom-41 ical observations, who shall make a report of his 42 doings, with an accurate description of such struc-43 ture, its latitude and longitude, and the declination 44 of the needle at the time, and deposit a record 45 thereof with the clerk of the courts for such county, 46 and shall be entitled to such just compensation for 47 his services as the governor and council may allow. Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
