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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-ONE.

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AN ACT to incorporate the town of Howard.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The township hitherto known by  
2 the name of Howard, in the county of Piscataquis,  
3 and being township number eight (8) in the eighth  
4 range north of the Waldo patent, be and hereby is  
5 incorporated into a town by the name of Howard,  
6 and the inhabitants of said town are hereby vested  
7 with all the powers, privileges and immunities  
8 which the inhabitants of towns within this state  
9 do or may enjoy.

SECT. 2. Any justice of the peace within said  
2 county, is hereby empowered to issue his warrant  
3 to some inhabitant of said town, directing him to

4 notify the inhabitants thereof to meet at such time  
5 and place as he shall appoint, to choose such  
6 officers, and transact such business as other towns  
7 are empowered to do at their annual town meetings.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
