## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Howard.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The township hitherto known by:
- 2 the name of Howard, in the county of Piscataquis,
- 3 and being township number eight (8) in the eighth-
- 4 range north of the Waldo patent, be and hereby is:
- 5 incorporated into a town by the name of Howard,
- 6 and the inhabitants of said town are hereby vested:
- 7 with all the powers, privileges and immunities
- 8 which the inhabitants of towns within this state
- 9 do or may enjoy.
  - Sect. 2. Any justice of the peace within said
- 2 county, is hereby empowered to issue his warrant
- 3 to some inhabitant of said town, directing him to

- 4 notify the inhabitants thereof to meet at such time
- 5 and place as he shall appoint, to choose such
- 6 officers, and transact such business as other towns
- 7 are empowered to do at their annual town meetings.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
