IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND-EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts.

- 2 and resolves of the legislature requiring the pay-
- 3 ment of money from the treasury, and also to provide
- 4 for the necessary expenditures of government for
- 5 the fiscal year eighteen hundred eighty-one, the
- 6 following sums are hereby appropriated out of any
- 7 moneys in the treasury, and the governor, with the
- 8 advice and consent of the council, is hereby author-
- 9 ized, at any time prior to the first day of January
- 10 next, to draw his warrant on the treasury for the
